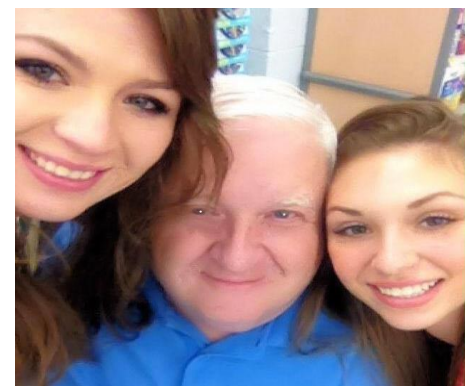
The curriculum for 1st through 5th grades is provided by Sylvan Learning LLC which has its own classroom pencil and paper instructional curriculum.
